

2018 Camp Ten Trees **Spring Camp** Packing List

Campers should bring luggage as listed below. It is strongly recommended that you attach or write the camper's name on all pieces of checked luggage (and all items you don't want to lose at camp). PLEASE DO NOT TIE ITEMS TOGETHER. Camp Ten Trees is not liable for any lost, damaged, or missing items. Take care in choosing what to bring. Dinner will be provided on the bus for campers.

- **1 Small Carry-On Bag:** This bag is for the first day of camp, as many campers do not get to their luggage until night time.
- **1 Medication Bag:** This small bag should be separate from other bags, and contain only camper's medications and razors.
- **1 Checked Bag:** This should have bedding and include most of the camper's belongings for their time at camp.
- **1 Instrument Case (Optional):** If your camper wants to bring an instrument, the case doesn't need to fit into other bags.

SMALL CARRY-ON BAG:

- Flashlight (With Extra Batteries/Wind-Up)
- Water Bottle
- Sweatshirt or Jacket
- Raincoat/Poncho

MEDICATION BAG:

Everything should be in original containers and stored together in a bag (such as a ziploc bag) that is clearly labeled with the camper's full name.

- Any Prescribed Medication
- Naturopathic Medicines
- Homeopathic Medicines
- Supplements or Vitamins
- Herbal Remedies
- Any Razors

This bag is to be turned into camp by guardians at Check-in.

CHECKED BAG:

- Extra Pair of Shoes
- Water Bottle
- Socks & Underwear
- Shirts
- Long Pants
- Sweater/Sweatshirt/Jacket

Suggestions/Optional Items

- Camera (Not Cell Phone)
- Watch (Not Cell Phone)
- Notebook/Sketchbook
- Reading Book
- Pajamas/Sleepwear
- Warm Layers
- Towels
- Toiletries (*shower essentials, soap, menstrual products, toothbrush & toothpaste, deodorant, etc.*)
- Warm Sleeping Bag or Blankets/Pillow
- Pens/Pencils/Markers
- Crafty Supplies/Playing Cards/Games
- Musical Instrument
- Swimwear (optional, for penguin plunge)

PLEASE DO NOT BRING THESE ITEMS - POSSESSION OF ANY OF THE FOLLOWING MAY LEAD TO A CAMPER BEING REQUIRED TO LEAVE CAMP EARLY:

- Pets
- Any Electronic Devices (Excluding Cameras)
- Weapons
- Drugs
- Sharp Things (ie: Scissors)
- Alcohol or Tobacco
- Food or Candy
- Offensive Clothing
- Matches or Lighters
- Undeclared Medication
- Valuables or Money
